





The deck is 60" long, 27" wide, and 21" high. Since my goats are all on the smaller side (1 yr), these dimensions might have to be increased a little to accomodate a larger, full-grown animal. A little higher wouldn't hurt either, so there wouldn't be so much bending when cutting hooves. If it is to be used for milking, then some accomodations should be made for that to allow ease of access.

The two 2 x 4s that make up the top bar (either side of the 2 x 2s, will have to be washered a little at the ends so that the 2 x 2s do not bind.

This was a quick and dirty construction and therefore is not particularly elegant. But it does work for holding them in place while hoof triming, etc.
